SECOND CALL FOR BIC/NAPIA PRESENTATIONS

This is the second call to alert authors who wish to present oral or poster presentations at the 2007 BIC/NAPIA Biennial Meetings. In order to guarantee inclusion of all abstracts in the BIC program booklet, please submit your abstract no later than Friday, September 14, 2007. Abstracts for the BIC should be submitted by email to Michell Sass <u>mesass@wisc.edu</u> Please indicate whether the presentation is for the oral or poster session and whether the presenter is a student. Abstracts submitted after September 14, 2007 will automatically be placed in the poster session and no abstracts will be accepted after Friday, September 28, 2007. Abstracts for NAPIA should be submitted to Kevin McPhee via email <u>kmcphee@mail.wsu.edu</u>.

Oral Presentations:

The presentations will be limited to 15 minutes (12 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for questions is suggested). The time limit will be enforced by the session chairperson. If all oral presentation requests cannot be accommodated, the program committee will move some presentations to the poster session. Authors will be notified if this placement is necessary.

Presentations will be organized into appropriate groups to the extent possible and the presenters will be notified of the presentation date and time prior to the meeting. All presentations must be in Power Point format. An LCD projector and computer will be provided. Please bring your presentations on a CD or USB drive to the audio visual manager prior to the beginning of the session.

Poster Sessions:

Posters must fit within an area of 48" x 48". Posters easels will be provided. The top portion of the poster should contain the title, authors, and affiliations.

Reports:

A paper (maximum of two pages in length) for each oral and poster presentation is requested for publication in the 2008 annual BIC report and for NAPIA Proceedings. An electronic copy of papers for the BIC annual report and NAPIA Proceedings should also be provided to the organizer during the meeting.

Abstract Format:

Please follow the following abstract format: PREPARING YOUR BIC OR NAPIA ABSTRACT IN THE PROPER FORMAT IS ESSENTIAL. Sass, M.E.^{1*} and Y.S. Chung¹. ¹Department of Horticulture, University of Wisconsin, Madison, WI. *Presenter (<u>mesass@wisc.edu</u>)

A blank line should separate the affiliation from the text. The abstract should be limited to two or three sentences in length. The total abstract should be no more than 6" wide and 2.5" high. The presenter should be identified with an asterisk after his/her name. The affiliations should be followed by the email address of the presenter. Abstracts should be typed in Times New Roman font, 12 pt. BIC abstracts should be submitted by email to Michell Sass <u>mesass@wisc.edu</u> as a Word document. NAPIA abstracts should be submitted to Kevin McPhee via email <u>kmcphee@mail.wsu.edu</u>
